STUDENT TO INSTRUCTOR RATIO

For instruction of the Criminal Justice Weapons Course and Firearms Instructor Course there shall be no more than six students actively engaged in training on a firearms range for each firearms instructor. Actively engaged is defined as "a student on the firing range handling a weapon."

Discretionary course of fire shall be conducted using a one-to-one student to instructor ratio.

ACTIVELY ENGAGED

Actively engaged is defined as "a student on the firing range handling a weapon."

PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE WEAPONS INSTRUCTOR COURSE

The Criminal Justice Firearms Instructor Course is required training for instructors who instruct firearms in a Traditional Basic Recruit Training Program and Criminal Justice Firearms Instructor Course. The instructor student shall demonstrate high-liability proficiency skills at 80% or higher on the Firearms Course of Fire with a handgun (revolver or semi-automatic pistol) with the results recorded on this form.

PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRADITIONAL BASIC RECRUIT TRAINING ACADEMY

Basic recruits shall, at minimum, be required to demonstrate proficiency at 80% or higher with the handgun. Failure to demonstrate proficiency by qualifying on the Firearms Certification Course of Fire is a failure in the Basic Recruit Academy.

FIREARMS COURSE OF FIRE

Handgun-Revolver Daylight	48 Round Course of fire.	Two qualifying scores of 38 or higher, twice, back to back with 2 in a row or 3 out of 6 attempts. Scoring area will be any hit that is inside or touches the exterior scoring line of the 4 or 5 zones.
Handgun-Revolver Subdued Light	48 Round Course of fire.	One qualifying score of 38 or higher, once out of two attempts. Scoring area will be any hit that is inside or touches the exterior scoring line of the 4 or 5 zones.
